HRR Director's Decree issued on 19 November 2021 Code: RKMZ/09/2021

Operation of TBU catering facilities from 22 November 2021 onwards due to COVID-19

- Tomas Bata University in Zlín (hereinafter referred to as "TBU") prohibits the entry of a diner (hereinafter referred to as a "person") into the indoor and outdoor areas of catering facilities if he/she shows clinical signs of the COVID-19 disease or, with the exemption of children under the age of 12, does not meet the requirements listed below:
 - a) The person evidences a negative result of an RT-PCR screening test for the detection of the presence of SARS-CoV-2 virus carried out in the last 72 hours, in the event that the person in question is:
 - i) a person under the age of 18, or
 - ii) a person who cannot undergo vaccination against COVID-19 for contraindications; the fact that a person cannot undergo vaccination against COVID-19 for contraindications shall be evidenced by a record in the Information System of Infectious Diseases (ISID) containing explicit information that a person cannot undergo vaccination against COVID-19 for health reasons, or by a medical certificate explicitly stating that a person cannot undergo vaccination against COVID-19 for health reasons and that this fact is included in the Information System of Infectious Diseases (ISID); or
 - iii) a person vaccinated against COVID-19 in the event that
 - a. no less than 14 days have elapsed since the first dose of vaccine was administered in the case of a single-dose regimen according to the Summary of Medicinal Product Characteristics (hereinafter referred to as "SPC") as at the date of evidencing of this fact for the purposes of this extraordinary measure, or
 - b. in the case of a two-dose regimen according to SPC, the person has not been given the second dose of vaccine yet, and the maximum amount set for the application of the second dose of vaccine according to SPC has not elapsed since the first dose of vaccine was administered as at the date of evidencing of this fact for the purposes of this extraordinary measure, or
 - c. no less than 14 days have elapsed since the second dose of vaccine was administered in the case of a two-dose regimen according to SPC as at the date of evidencing of this fact for the purposes of this extraordinary measure; or
 - b) the person has been vaccinated against the COVID-19 disease and provides evidence of this fact by presenting a national vaccination certificate or a certificate issued in accordance with the European Union Regulation on the EU digital COVID certificate, provided that at least 14 days have elapsed since the vaccination regimen was completed; a national certificate of vaccination refers to a written confirmation issued at least in English by an authorized entity operating in a third country, a template of which is included in the list of recognized national certificates posted on the website of the Ministry of Health of the Czech Republic; the written confirmation must include

details of the person vaccinated, the type of vaccine administered, the date the vaccine was administered, the identification of the entity which issued the certificate, and all data must be verifiable by remote access directly from the written confirmation, provided that vaccination was carried out using

- i) a medicinal product containing a vaccine against COVID-19 which has been granted a marketing authorization in accordance with the Regulation (EC) No. 726/2004, or
- a medicinal product the manufacture of which complies with the patent of the medicinal product referred to in Clause i), provided that the medicinal product has also been approved by the World Health Organization for emergency use; or
 - c) the person has already had the COVID-19 disease which has been confirmed by a laboratory and his/her isolation period has expired, and no more than 180 days have elapsed since the first positive rapid antigen test (RAT) for the detection of the presence of SARS-CoV-2 virus antigen or since the RT-PCR test for the detection of the presence of SARS-CoV-2 virus.
- 2. The fulfilment of requirements listed in Clause 1 shall be checked at the entrance to catering facilities, persons are obliged to provide evidence of having fulfilled the requirements listed in Clause 1; a person who fails to provide evidence of having fulfilled the requirements at the entrance, shall not be allowed to enter the TBU catering facilities.
