

HRR Director's Decree issued on 19 November 2021
Code: RKMZ/10/2021

Operation of TBU accommodation facilities from 22 November 2021 onwards due to COVID-19

- 1) Tomas Bata University in Zlín (hereinafter referred to as “TBU”) prohibits the entry of those persons into the accommodation facilities who show clinical signs of the COVID-19 disease or do not meet the requirements listed below:
 - a) The person has been vaccinated against the COVID-19 disease and provides evidence of this fact by presenting a national vaccination certificate or a certificate issued in accordance with the European Union Regulation on the EU digital COVID certificate, provided that at least 14 days have elapsed since the vaccination regimen was completed; a national certificate of vaccination refers to a written confirmation issued at least in English by an authorized entity operating in a third country, a template of which is included in the list of recognized national certificates posted on the website of the Ministry of Health of the Czech Republic; the written confirmation must include details of the person vaccinated, the type of vaccine administered, the date the vaccine was administered, the identification of the entity which issued the certificate, and all data must be verifiable by remote access directly from the written confirmation, provided that vaccination was carried out using
 - i) a medicinal product containing a vaccine against COVID-19 which has been granted a marketing authorization in accordance with the Regulation (EC) No. 726/2004, or
 - ii) a medicinal product the manufacture of which complies with the patent of the medicinal product referred to in Clause i), provided that the medicinal product has also been approved by the World Health Organization for emergency use; or
 - b) the person has already had the COVID-19 disease which has been confirmed by a laboratory and his/her isolation period has expired, and no more than 180 days have elapsed since the first positive rapid antigen test (RAT) for the detection of the presence of SARS-CoV-2 virus antigen or since the RT-PCR test for the detection of the presence of SARS-CoV-2 virus, or
 - c) the person evidences a negative result of an RT-PCR screening test for the detection of the presence of SARS-CoV-2 virus carried out in the last 72 hours, or the person evidences a negative result of a rapid antigen test (RAT) carried out by a healthcare professional in the last 24 hours and aimed at the detection of the presence of SARS-CoV-2 virus.
- 2) Persons are obliged to evidence the facts specified under Clause 1 prior to the commencement of accommodation and, afterwards, once per 7 days, with the exemption of requirements referred to in Clauses 1 a) and b), which shall be evidenced only once, i.e. before the commencement of accommodation. Those persons who fail to provide evidence of any of the facts specified in the previous sentence will not be allowed to enter the TBU accommodation facility in compliance with the extraordinary measures currently in force. In order to fulfil the requirements referred to in the first sentence, the TBU accommodation facility is obliged to control the provision of evidence of the requirements set out with regard to the free movement of persons (i.e. different times of arrivals of persons) and, thus, the accommodated person shall be requested to evidence that he/she has fulfilled the requirements referred to in the first sentence every time when entering a TBU accommodation facility.

- 3) In case of a positive result of the test for the detection of the presence of the SARS-CoV-2 virus antigen during accommodation, the student is immediately separated from other persons and has to move to a quarantine room. A student who has a permanent place of residence in the Czech Republic will not be allowed to stay in the accommodation facility. The student shall follow the **Card of Instructions to Be Followed When Experiencing COVID-19 Symptoms**.
- 4) The HRR Director's Decree RKMZ/08/2021 issued on 27 October 2021 shall be abrogated after the issuance of this Decree, with the exemption of Appendices No. 1, 2, 3 and 4 to the RKMZ/08/2021, which shall remain in force.
