Dear students,

The canteen of the central canteen of UTB Zlín on Univerzita Street is currently undergoing a complete reconstruction. This is mainly due to the obsolescence of the technical equipment. The existing technologies of the catering equipment no longer correspond to modern operational and technical requirements, therefore a new concept of catering operation has been designed, which will significantly speed up the check-in of customers and enable greater automation of the operation with more efficient use of space and staff.

Due to the unplanned postponement of the construction works until October 2023, it is necessary to adjust the operations of the existing catering operations between September and October as follows:

The U4 University Canteen will be:

- o only the employee canteen with a seating capacity of 122 for both staff and students,
- an expanded range of packed and sterilised meals,
- extended opening hours for lunch from 10am to 3pm.
- Preferential use by FMK and FHS students is recommended.

The U13 restaurant will be:

- o increased seating capacity to 200, in the restaurant and in the adjacent 1st floor area,
- the possibility to buy packaged food at the collection point next to the restaurant (existing cloakroom),
- extended opening hours for lunch from 10 am to 3 pm.
- We recommend priority use by FHS, FT and FMK students.

The Garni Hotel will be:

- the possibility of eating in the restaurant with a capacity of 60 seats and the use of the lounge on the second floor with a seating capacity of 45,
- extended opening hours for lunch from 10:30 am to 2 pm.
- We recommend priority use by FAME and FT students.

The cafeteria in the U2 building will be:

- Increased number of hot food portions,
- extended opening hours until 3pm.
- Priority use by FAME, FT students is recommended.

The cafeteria in Building U5 will be:

- increased number of portions of hot meals,
- extended opening hours until 3pm.
- We recommend priority use by FAI and FT students.

During the renovation period, the selection of hot meals will be limited to only three types.

From the beginning of September through the end of October, packaged meals will be sold in all dining locations without payment for packaging (meals will already be packaged for faster check-in of diners).

To ensure smooth operations, students are asked to vacate their seats as soon as possible after consumption.

We hope that with your help we can get through this difficult time. HRR staff will be as helpful as possible with any questions you may have.
