

List of permitted electrical appliances from 1 May 2025

This list applies to UTB university halls of residence and external accommodation facilities (Garni, MSI, Max32).

Permitted electrical appliances

✓ Kitchen appliances (only allowed in kitchens not equipped with appliances listed below):

- Microwave oven (heating only, no grill)
- Electric kettle
- Toaster, toaster, waffle maker

✓ Other appliances (allowed in rooms):

- Flashlight
- Computer, laptop, tablet, printer/multifunctional device
- Vacuum cleaner
- Personal hygiene appliances (e.g. hairdryer, shaver)
- Extension cord

Rules for the use of electrical appliances

♦ All appliances must comply with the ČSN standard and must not have a power output of more than 1.5 kW per appliance.

♦ The total power of kitchen appliances in the kitchens of accommodation cells and apartments must not exceed 4 kW.

♦ Kitchen appliances cannot be used in the rooms.

Exception for guests staying in Hotel Garni

Students staying in Hotel Garni, where the room does not include a refrigerator, can bring their own refrigerator (max. volume 120 L, including freezer) after agreement with the manager. The refrigerator must have a valid inspection according to the standard ČSN 33 160.

Possibility to bring other electrical appliances for a fee

By prior arrangement and payment of a fee according to the price list of services can be brought:

ightharpoonup Electric musical instrument – only with the consent of the roommates and in compliance with the nighttime rules. In case of noise complaints, the instrument must be removed.

 $\dot{\mathcal{R}}$ Electric scooter or electric bike – storage is only allowed in the bike room (if available). If the wheelhouse is not equipped for the storage of these vehicles, their storage cannot be allowed.

Portable fan/air cooler (allowed from 1 May to 30 September).

- ∋ Air purifier.
- Coffee maker,
- **Rice Cooker**

NOther electrical appliances required for study or medical reasons (subject to prior approval).

Penalties for breaking the rules

 \triangle The use of unauthorised or non-compliant appliances is charged according to the Schedule of Damages and Penalties.

▲ Repeated violations may lead to termination of the Accommodation Agreement.
